As of April 2022, Hunter Rugby has 1280 active registrations with four Winter competitions – Premier, Divisional, Women's, 4th Grade and two Summer 7s competitions made up of Women's and Colts teams.

Junior Rugby

Junior rugby is a key development priority of HRU to build and retain the love of rugby of players and keep them playing our great game. HRU recognises the importance of juniors and the pathway required to nurture their interests, performance and knowledge of the game.

HRU is dedicated to assisting each club with its junior program and its goals of creating a sustainable program for the club's benefit and the strength of rugby in the Hunter.

As of 2021, HRU Junior Rugby participation consists of 124 junior teams with 2167 registrations;

- U7's through to U18's in Boys XV a side
- U14's and U16's Girls XV a side
- U15's and U17's Girls Summer/Spring 7's
